What to expect in this series?

- The ENRIITC project aims to build a permanent pan-European network of Industrial Liaison and Contact Officers (ILOs and ICOs) and enable industry to become a full partner of research infrastructures whether it is as a user, a supplier, or a co-creator.
- ENRITC your Knowledge is a series of online training and organisational webinars targeted to experts involved in setting up collaborations between Research Infrastructures and Industry, such as ILO and ICO.
- The overall aim of this webinar series is to share knowledge, expertise, skills and best practices amongst ILOs and ICOs.
- ENRIITC project is led by the European Spallation Source with five RIs and five ILO organisations in the consortium.



Scope of the webinar

This **1st ENRITC your Knowledge webinar**, will be exploring two important roles:

- **ILO** (**Industry Liaison Officers**), officially appointed by the member states and associated countries to stimulate the collaboration among the national industry and the international RIs;
- ICO (Industry Contact Officers), research infrastructures staff in charge of developing business relations with all potential industrial suppliers and users.

One of the main goals of the ENRIITC project is paving the way for future synergies and collaborations between these two crucial roles. Different ILOs and ICOs will present their views on their role and key performance indicators.

This should provide the basis for exploiting the full potential of RI-Industry interaction.


Franciska de Jong, CLARIN ERIC
